WHAT IS TITLE I?

Title I is a federally funded program designed to improve educational opportunities. These programs serve students who meet the criteria for supplemental instruction in core academics, with a primary focus on literacy and math skills.

WHEN DOES MY CHILD RECEIVE TITLE I SERVICES?

Title I services cannot occur during core instruction time. That means that your student will remain in the classroom for the entire reading and math block designated by their teacher. They will receive Title I services during our Tiger Time- a designated time for all students to receive interventions/enrichments! Students will receive services 4-5 days a week for thirty minutes.

HOW DOES MY CHILD QUALIFY FOR THIS EXTRA HELP?

We use district assessments and classroom assessments to help determine extra help for the students. For reading, we utilize the DIBELS Next assessment, in addition to classroom assessments. STAR math and classroom assessments are used to help determine students that may need extra help for math.

WHAT WILL MY CHILD BE DOING DURING THIS TIME?

Title I uses many different research based programs to supplement the curriculum. We look closely at data, as well as discussion with teachers to decide what program best meets the needs of your child. Students are continuously monitored while in the programs, to see if changes need to be made. We consistently meet with teachers to ensure what we teach in group transfers to the classroom!

HOW WILL I KNOW HOW MY CHILD IS DOING?
