- _____ 1 zip-up binder/trapper keeper (at least **2 in. is recommended**)
- _____ **1 in. three ring binder** (will be used for organizing math sheets)
- _____ **3 solid colored, two-pocket, NO pronged** folders. If possible try to find folders that have three punched holes, so they can be securely stored inside the binder. You will need **1 green, 1 blue, and 1 yellow folder**
- _____ **1 folder of your choice**, but again, make sure it has two pockets, no prongs, and it can be secured in the binder
- _____ **2** college ruled, 1 subject notebooks (70 pages will do)
- _____ **1** small pencil case/pouch that can **easily be stored** in your desk
- _____ **2 dozen** no. 2 pencils (mechanical will work if preferred)
- _____ **4** highlighters (colors can vary)
- _____ **8** Expo dry erase markers (black preferred)
- _____ **1** old sock for cleaning off white boards
- _____ **2** rolls of scotch tape
- _____ **1** pair of scissors
- _____ **colored pencils** (box size can vary, but stay away from the mega packs)
- _____ **markers** (box size can vary, but stay away from the mega packs)
- _____ **1 pair of headphones/earbuds** with **in-line mic** (for example the *Califone E3T Classroom Stereo Earbuds*).
- _____ **2** box of **Kleenex**
- _____ **1** container of **Clorox, antibacterial wipes**
