Honors English 9:

**All students need to read:**

Honors English 10:

**1. Choose one work from the following:**

**2. All students need to read:**

IB English HL 1 (11<sup>th</sup> grade):

1. **Choose a novel written by one of the following authors:** Margaret Atwood, Charlotte Brontë, Michael Crichton (not *Jurassic Park*), Charles Frazier, Jamaica Kincaid or Kurt Vonnegut (not *Welcome to the Monkey House* or any short story collection).
2. **Choose one of the following titles:** *Columbine* (Dave Cullen), *Born on a Blue Day* (Daniel Tammet), *Missoula* (Jon Krakauer), *The Color of Water* (James McBride), *The Liars' Club* (Mary Karr), or *Unbroken* (Laura Hillenbrand), *Strength in What Remains* (Tracy Kidder).

IB English HL 2 (12<sup>th</sup> grade):

1. **Book of student's choice at the IB reading level** (however, you may not read one of the previous summer reading titles/authors, or a book or author on the IB2 curriculum list—see letter).
2. **All students need to read:** *The Housekeeper and the Professor* by Yoko Ogawa (translated from Japanese by Stephen Snyder)
