

Glen C. Smith, Jr./Kalamazoo Country Club Caddie Scholarship 2011

Scholarship Information

The Glen C. Smith, Jr./KCC Caddie Scholarship was established at the Kalamazoo Community Foundation in 1985 by the Kalamazoo Country Club Caddie Committee in honor of Glen Smith, Jr. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide scholarship assistance to young people in qualified caddie programs at member clubs of the Golf Association of Michigan and the Western Golf Association.

Eligibility Criteria

Graduating high school senior who is a Kalamazoo County resident or attends a Kalamazoo County high school. Golf caddie at a member club of the Golf Association of Michigan or the Western Golf Association with a minimum of 12 rounds per season; GPA that demonstrates potential for success in a vocational or degree-granting program; extracurricular activities; financial need.

How to Apply

Access the online scholarship application, eGrant, via the Community Foundation's Web site at www.kalfound.org. Click on **Scholarship Information**, then **eGrant**.

Application Requirements

The following must be submitted to the Kalamazoo Community Foundation:

- eGRANT scholarship application and cover page (automatically generated by eGRANT upon completion of the application).
- Activities and Employment History form must be filled out and attached to the eGRANT application.
- Essay, not to exceed 500 typewritten words, must be written and attached to the eGRANT application. Address why you merit consideration for this scholarship. Include how extra-curricular activities, volunteer experiences and leadership roles have helped to prepare you for your choice of study. If you have overcome challenges or improved in motivation and achievement during high school and/or college, please provide this information also.

The following must be mailed or delivered to the Kalamazoo Community Foundation by March 31:

- Two copies of the Scholarship Recommendation form and Letters of Recommendation. One copy of the form must be completed by your high school principal, guidance counselor, or a teacher. One copy of the form must be completed by the Caddie Superintendent, Golf Pro or Committee member at the place of caddie service.
- An official transcript, including ACT/SAT scores, through the seventh semester.

The following must be sent to the college(s) of your choice by March 31:

- The Financial Information Summary form.
