## **JACK MOSS SCHOLARSHIP 2011**

### ***Scholarship Information***

This scholarship program was established 1985 in honor of Jack Moss, **Kalamazoo Gazette** sports editor (now retired), for the purpose of recognizing academic and athletic accomplishments of graduating high school seniors in Kalamazoo County.

### ***Nominee Criteria***

To be considered for a Jack Moss Scholarship, a student must:

- Be a graduating high school senior who is a Kalamazoo County resident or enrolled at a high school within Kalamazoo County.
- Have earned a G.P.A. of at least a 3.00 through the first semester/term of the senior year
- Have earned a varsity letter as a senior
- Be planning to attend Kalamazoo College, Kalamazoo Valley Community College, or Western Michigan University as a full-time student for the upcoming fall and spring semesters or equivalent terms.

### ***Nomination Process***

Nomination forms are distributed annually to the high schools by the chairperson of the advisory committee.

One female and one male candidate are nominated by the athletic director and/or coaches of each high school in Kalamazoo County. Schools may not nominate candidates who have previously been awarded full-ride scholarships.

### ***Award***

\$1,000 (non-renewable)

### ***Deadline***

The athletic directors of all Kalamazoo County high schools will be notified in April or early May by the advisory committee chairperson that it is time to begin the selection process for the Jack Moss Scholarship.

Nominations must be returned to the selection advisory committee by mid-May. Award recipients are notified during the month of May.
