Soccer	Brian Thiele Memorial	Graduating high school senior who is a Kalamazoo County resident or attends a Kalamazoo County high school; four years of participation on a soccer team during high school; can demonstrate efforts to give back to the community; description of any obstacles encountered and their resolution. Planning to pursue a certificate or two- or four-year degree full time. Financial need may be a consideration, but is not a requirement for application. Minimum \$500 award	December-10	3/31/11
All Sports	Derek Jeter	Graduating high school senior who is a Kalamazoo County resident or attends a Kalamazoo County high school; planning to pursue a two- or four-year degree full time; demonstration of leadership, including fitness and sportsmanship, while advocating a substance-free lifestyle. Minority applicants are encouraged. \$1,000 renewable award to one female and one male.	December-10	3/31/11
