It is hard to believe that we are approaching the end of our school year. We have continued to progress with our Spanish this semester. During the third quarter, our unit focused on learning the shapes in Spanish. At the end of our shapes unit, the students did a classroom search where they tried to tally as many of these shapes that they spied around their classroom. During the next unit, the students focused on learning their numbers from 1- 10 in Spanish. We learned the numbers through stories and songs. For example , “Cinco Monitos Saltando en la Cama” (Five little Monkeys Jumping on the Bed) helped us remember our numbers from 0-5 in Spanish. “Diez Pequeñas Mariquitas” (Ten Little Ladybugs) was our story to help us recognize numbers up to ten. Once the students were able to recognize their numbers, we reviewed both colors and numbers in Spanish with our story- “Gatos, Gatos”. Each child had a chance to act out part of our story about counting colored cats. Each student also had their own story book that they helped create. I hope that you had a chance to see your child’s Spanish version of this book.
